Children must be accepted to Fremont Christian School (FCS) through a formal admissions process. Both parental involvement and student cooperation are essential for FCS to fulfill its mission. Please complete the following requirements:

- 1. Parents must provide FCS with a completed application form for each child applying for admissions, including academic records, health forms, or previous tests/screeners.
- 2. Parents must sign the form stating their acknowledgment of our Statement of Faith as an expression of who we are and what will be taught in the classroom.
- Parents and students must be willing to abide by the school's rules and regulations as expressed in the handbook, and must agree and be supportive of the school procedures for handling student discipline.
- 4. It is important to be active members of the Body of Christ and regularly attend a Christian church.
- 5. Each prospective student/family will go through an interview process as well as an evaluation with FCS's placement specialist. This evaluation will provide FCS with a baseline on each student's strengths and weaknesses and will be reviewed a second time at the end of the school year to evaluate student growth.
